THINGS TO KNOW

DROP OFF/PICK UP:

- ◆ We welcome kids in class at 10:45AM with a name tag. Please present the parent sticker and return the pager at pick up.
- ◆ Please let us know of any allergies or special needs!

SAFETY:

- ◆ In the event of an emergency, meet your children at the back of the Stewart Ave Parking Lot.
- ◆ All Belmont Kids volunteers are required to clear a background check.

SCHEDULE:

- ◆ Our elementary age kiddos are in service about once a month. We believe this will help both our kids and parents, so kids are prepared by 6th grade to attend service and parents are prepared to have them in service regularly. *See the calendar on reverse for dates!*
