## SOAP

One method of going through the Bible that we recommend to go through the Family Bible Study Journal is the SOAP Method.

#### **Scripture**

Passages of scripture are chosen for each day, 5 days per week. Read the passage aloud with your children. Your kids can even take turns reading! Your family is also welcome to each have a notebook or sketchbook to draw, color or write as they listen to the reading as well.

#### **Observation**

Spend some time discussing what you heard going on in the passage or story you read.

Take time to notice the who, what, when, where, etc.

#### **Application**

Based on what was happening in the passage or story, what lessons can you apply or what commands are there for you to follow that God has given.

#### Pray

Pray as a family for the Lord to help you to apply what you have read about together.

## THE GOSPEL

The Gospel is the good news about Christ's birth, death on the cross, resurrection three days later, and the salvation we have from sin because of Him. Below are the most important aspects for kids to learn as they grow to trust in Christ.



## God is King

- The Bible tells us that God is creator of everyone and everything, and that we are created in His Image. He is in charge of everything!

#### We Sin

- The Bible tells us that we all sin. Sin is rejecting God in the world he created by not being or doing what he requires in His law.

## **God Made a Way Through Jesus**

- God sent His son Jesus to live a perfect life, die on the cross for our sins and rise three days later. He saved us from the punishment we deserve because we couldn't pay for it on our own. Jesus alone saves us from sin!

#### We Respond to God

- You can receive the gift of grace through faith in Jesus alone by believing in His death and resurrection as a payment for your sin. Turn from your sin to Jesus, tell others about Him, and eagerly await His return!

#### Day 1 - Matthew 9: 27-31 - The story of Jesus Healing two blind men

#### Day 2 - John 3: 1-18 - The story of Nicodemus

Nicodemus knew a lot of stuff, he was a Pharisee, a ruler of the Jewish people.
 But he needed to believe in Jesus or trust in Jesus as Lord.

#### Day 3 - Matthew 13:1-23- Parable of the Sower

 How does a plant grow? What does it need to grow? Have you ever seen a plant grow What happened?

#### Day 4 - Mark 4: 1-9 - Parable of the Sower

• Pick two of the locations of where the seed landed and discuss them with your kids.

#### Day 5 - Luke 8: 5-8 - Parable of the Sower

 Discuss the two other locations where the seeds fell and discuss them with your kids.

#### **Family Time Ideas**

- Scripture Memory Memorize John 3:16-17 as a family. Make up a song, some hand motions or a dance to help you remember it.
- Game idea: play the typical "trust game" where the child stands about 2 feet from the parent (front to back). The child then let's go and "falls" backward. The parent catches her by the armpits. The first few times, the child will probably want to step back to "catch" herself, but the point is to trust that the parent will catch her and keep her from falling.
- Activity idea: Take a nature walk and look at all the plants. Talk about how they
  grow. What around them helped them grow? Is there anything around that made
  it harder for them to grow?

Who was pushing the children away? What was Jesus' response?

#### Family activity ideas -

- <u>Scripture memory</u>: Memorize Matthew 22: 37-39 as a family. Use a song, hand motions or a dance to help it stick!
- <u>Game idea</u>: Play hide and seek with your family.
- Activity idea: Make a project of concentric circles showing many places you belong. Cut a small circle and write your name on it or have someone help you write your name on it. Cut a slightly larger circle and write "Our Home" on it. Cut a slightly larger circle and write your city on it. Cut a larger circle and write your state on it. Cut the largest circle and write God's World on it. Feel free to be creative with your circles. It's fun to see all the places we belong and that ultimately it all belongs to God.
