- D. Confess your sin to your divorced spouse and ask for forgiveness.
- E. Be reconciled with your divorced spouse and renew your vows with the intent to build a Kingdom Marriage together.
- F. Remain single if your attempts to reconcile fail.
- G. You may remarry if your divorced spouse dies.
- H. Use your experience to encourage other couples to avoid divorce.
